

## COVID-19 Protocol School Year 2021-2022

-Schools have 10 district wide NTI days available for SY 21-22.

-Schools have 20 additional flexible remote learning days for small scale closures (Non-Districtwide)

-Students and Staff who maintain social distancing and wear masks properly have a greater chance of avoiding quarantine and allowing school to remain open.

-"Test to Stay" protocols are being developed that will allow students & staff to opt in for daily testing after in-school exposure to avoid quarantine from school.

-Masking on buses remains in effect per Federal Regulation.

## Green Tier:

Traditional school; masks are not required.

Social distancing may still be in place.

Routine cleaning and disinfecting continues.

Green in district will be determined in consultation with the local Health Department unless metric is determined by Public Health.

## Yellow Tier:

The building principal/designee(s) will determine if/when to cancel the presence of volunteers for classroom activities, guest readers, and other activities.

Indoor extracurricular events will continue and masks may be recommended to be worn by spectators.

Masks or shields may be required on the move in hallways, in large gathering areas and/or may be removed in the classroom if social distancing is in place.

Mask breaks for up to 10 minutes per hour are encouraged.

Social distancing is remains in place.

Frequent routine cleaning and disinfecting continues throughout the day.

Yellow in district will be determined in consultation with the local Health Department unless metric is determined by Public Health.

## Red Tier:

The building principal/designee(s) will determine if/when to cancel the presence of volunteers for classroom activities, guest readers, and other activities.

Non-essential volunteers and visitors must have principal permission to enter.

If there are too many cases within a classroom or school; flexible or remote learning days may be implemented as a mitigation strategy.

If there is not enough staff or there are too many positive or quarantined students to safely or effectively open school, NTI days may be utilized.

Masks or shields will be required but mask breaks for up to 10 minutes per hour are encouraged.

Frequent routine cleaning and disinfecting continues throughout the day.
