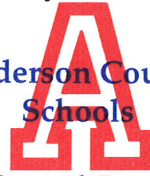

Dear Anderson County Schools Families:

As you may already know, Kentucky adopted new content standards that outline what students need to learn by the end of the year. Last year was the first year our teachers began teaching more challenging material based on the new standards. This past spring, our students were assessed using a new state test called the Kentucky Performance Rating for Education Progress (K-PREP). Not only was the material more challenging, but the scores students must meet to reach proficiency are higher too.

Last week, the state released the new test scores based on the new measures of success. Anderson County Schools ranked in the top 35% of all the schools districts in Kentucky. Robert B. Turner Elementary School ranked in the top 16% of all elementary schools and Anderson County High School ranked in the top 24% of all high schools in the state!

This is the beginning of a new way of teaching and learning for your students, staff, school and community. We have spent the last few months anticipating these test results and have already implemented new strategic plans in every school to make sure that each and every student excels in the classroom and shows significant yearly growth.

We are confident that Anderson County Schools are on the right path to continue and grow with success.
