"MUST-HAVES" - Everyone needs to get these items:

Personal Property - please write names on these

1. School box
2. 1 clipboard
3. Bottle of Glue + at least 4 glue sticks
4. 1 pair of scissors
5. An OLD shirt to be used during Art Class to protect clothing from messy projects
6. yellow, red, blue & green CHEAP 2-pocket folders with no prongs - Please do not write names on folders
7. 3-ring binder - any design
8. 2 boxes of 24-count crayons
9. 3-ring pencil pouch for binder
